Full time music majors (except percussion) from any Indiana university or college are eligible. Previous winners may not apply in the category in which they have won a prize. Times will be given to the first 10 applicants in the undergraduate category with auditions running from 9:00 through 11:00 a.m. The first 15 applicants in the graduate instrumental category will be scheduled between 12:30 and 4:45 p.m. **Bring two copies of your music for the judges.** You must provide your own accompanist.

Graduate prizes: 1st \$2500 2nd \$1500. Undergraduate: 1st \$1250 2nd \$1000.
