BRING TWO COMPLETE SETS OF YOUR MUSIC TO THE COMPETITION FOR THE JUDGES. Music must be memorized and you must provide your own accompanist. Auditions will be a maximum of 12 minutes in duration. Times will be given to the first 10 applicants in each category. Piano auditions are scheduled from 9:30 to 11:30 a.m. and voice auditions from 12:30 to 2:30 p.m. All competitors will be notified of the winners by email. First prize in each category is \$1250.00 and second prize is \$1000.00.
